8th Annual Hindu-Jewish School Supplies Donation - Benefits Austin, Manor and Pflugerville ISD, Children of Veterans and other Homeless Children

AUSTIN, TX, JULY 6, 2018: After another successful [Bollywood Meets Borscht Belt](#) fundraising event, [Hindu Charities For America](#) (HC4A) and the Austin Area Jewish Community are honored to continue with a joint community service project to help with the education of homeless children in Del Valle, Manor, Pflugerville and Austin Texas, children of veterans and other communities. This unique service project is the first one ever in Austin and is in its 7th year. Volunteers will pack school supplies for over 1,200 homeless children on Sunday, August 11, 2019 from 12.30 pm to 4:00 pm at the Dell Jewish Community Campus, located in Northwest Austin at 7300 Hart Lane, Community Hall Stage Side. This family friendly event will be complemented by post event dances by participating children.

Additionally, there will be an Essay Competition on the theme of selfless giving, with cash prizes.

For the seventh year, both Jewish and Hindu communities joined hands for a successful fundraiser, which exceeded its goal of \$25,000 to purchase school supplies for homeless children in the Austin metro area. Since its inception in 2010 HC4A, has served Round Rock, Austin, Bastrop, Pflugerville, Leander, Manor and Del Valle independent school districts (ISDs), children of veterans and other organizations.
